



PYMATUNING OUTBOARD MOTOR CLUB ORGANIZATION RULES



1. The Pymatuning Outboard Motor Club is for members and their families. If you, as a member, bring a guest onto the club property, you are responsible for their conduct.
2. Only **members**, no non-members, can take the boats from the docks. Club members taking another club member's boat from the dock must have written permission from the boat owner prior to taking the boat.
3. **State law:** Children under 12 and non-swimmers must wear life jackets while on club docks. No running or horseplay on docks.
4. **State law:** No swimming allowed except in designated areas. The state does allow bobbing in the lake. Your boat must be turned off & you must have a life jacket on. Stay within 10 ft. of your boat.
5. **State law:** No sleeping on boats overnight.
6. **State law:** All boats docked at club must display a valid mooring permit, as well as proper state registration.
7. **State law: No** fishing is permitted on the docks from April 1st thru October 31st. Members are permitted to fish from their docked boats, but only on their own slip.
8. All pets must be on a leash. No dogs are allowed in the picnic area or tied to the picnic tables. Clean up after your pets.
9. No equipment is to be left on dock walkways; rope, fishing equipment, etc.
10. All vehicles will observe a 10 mile per hour speed limit.
11. If you have small children on club grounds, please be careful. We love them too.
12. Parking is permitted only in designated areas. Boat trailers may be backed onto grassy areas, but tow vehicle must remain on the parking lot.
13. At the end of the boating season, all members are responsible for removing tires, ropes and any other equipment from their docks. (A \$10.00 fee will be billed to the member to cover the cost of removing any items after November 1)
14. Family of members under 18 must be accompanied by a club member. All family of members over 18 years old must be a member or accompanied by a club member.
15. All members must display their membership card upon request of any officer or director of the club when on club grounds. (Loaning to or use of a membership card by a non-member is not permitted.)
16. Large picnics or reunions, or other large gatherings of guests by a club member will not be permitted on days of club functions. (i.e.: July hot dog bash, annual picnic in Aug., etc.)
17. Anyone removing club property from the club grounds without permission will lose their membership and face possible criminal prosecution.
18. Docks are not transferrable. Only the boat assigned to a dock is to be in it.
19. Carpeting or any other material is not permitted to be placed (secured) to the wooden dock tops or sides.
20. Application for dock and membership must be received by March 15th of each year. After that date the dock will be given to the next person on the waiting list.
